Humanitarian Crisis in Myanmar

In response to the Rohingya situation in Myanmar, the Canadian Catholic Organization for Development and Peace (Caritas Canada) is working with Caritas Bangladesh to support a food distribution program along the Bangladesh/Myanmar border. Development and Peace is also assisting Bangladeshis with food and other emergency relief to help relieve the enormous strain that the refugee crisis is having on their own country's very limited resources. To assist the victims of this humanitarian crisis, Development and Peace has set up a Myanmar Crisis Relief Fund. Until November 28th the Government of Canada will match all donations to that fund and to the relief efforts of other eligible Canadian charitable organizations.
