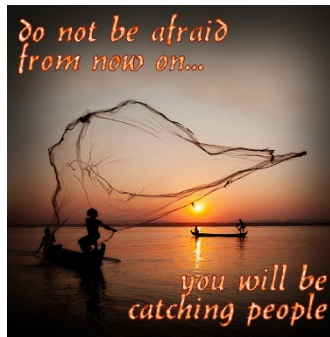

From the Archbishop

Archbishop Mulhall announces the following **provisional arrangements** during this period of study and review, **effective 1 February 2022:**

- Rev. Jan Kusyk is appointed Administrator of St-Francois d'Assise, Kingston. Father Kusyk will continue to serve as Chaplain to Newman House.
- Rev. James Quirk is appointed Administrator of Sacred Heart of Mary, Wolfe Island.
- Rev. Oliver Wekesa is appointed Administrator of St Patrick, Lansdowne. Father Oliver will live in residence at St Mary's Cathedral Rectory, Kingston.
- Archbishop Mulhall will retain for himself the office of Pastor of St Patrick, Railton and the Mission of St Mary, Odessa.
- Rev. Roberto Wojcik is delegated the administrative responsibilities for St Patrick, Railton and St Mary, Odessa.
- Rev. Sebastian Amato will provide the sacraments to St Patrick, Railton and St Barnaby, Brewers Mills.
- Rev. Paul Mawalla will provide the sacraments to St Mary, Odessa.
