Children's Liturgy has been delayed until June. If you would like to volunteer, please call the parish office as soon as possible. 613-389-2009.

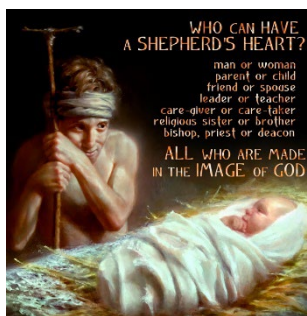
Dates to Remember
