**Food Drive**

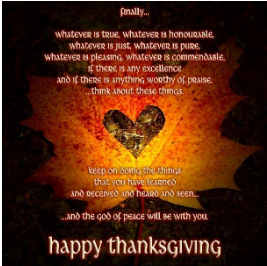
Each month our parish will collect for the Food Bank. **The next parish Food Drive is October 7/8.** Please make cheques payable to: "Partners In Mission Food Bank".
