

Summary of Fr. Americo's Homily

This Sunday's readings speak of an invitation to the Great Banquet of our Lord Jesus. The First Reading is a prophesy. It speaks of the Great Feast that is to come to bring joy and salvation. The Second Reading reflects how God provides for our needs according to Saint Paul. The Gospel tells us that God invites everyone to His Kingdom and to the Banquet of His Son Jesus: The Eucharistic, but few accept His invitation. We have already accepted God's invitation through our Baptism, but we need to be always prepared spiritually to give Him a good account at the end of our life and we need to receive Jesus' Body and Blood every time we come to Mass worthily.
