Church Maintenance: Many of us take for granted the exceptional condition of our 75+ year old church. In addition to the normal annual maintenance, there have been many significant upgrades and repairs over recent years, including a furnace replacement, repaired all the window frames, installed stained glass windows, addition of air conditioning, and many others.

This year we have been faced with some significant challenges. Early in the year, flooding in the washroom was one of them. We also have had the outside stucco walls repaired and washed. They now require a full professional painting which is planned for later this year or in the spring. The south wall roof flashing is leaking and requires inspection and repair. Pat Kennedy, our Property and Maintenance leader, has done an exceptional job in identifying and responding to all of these needs.

The cost for this work has, or will, exceed \$20,000. Thanks to our dedicated Bingo volunteers, all of these costs will be covered by the income generated from their efforts.
