Seven Last Words – Good Friday, April 14: On Good Friday, April 14, from 12 noon to 2 p.m. at St. Mary's Cathedral, the students of Newman House will be leading the Seven Last Words devotion – readings, meditations and music which prayerfully recall the seven times that Jesus speaks from the Cross.
