**Helmet Lifesaver:** The Canada Safety Council has developed a lifesaving Medical Data Carrier for motorcycle helmets. It is a unique medical information system in event of a motorcycle emergency. It can also be utilized on helmets of other riders such as bicycle, snowmobile, etc. It is be attached to the left side of the helmet and contains information as to the riders identity and medical history, including such things as allergies, medications, blood type, and pre-existing medical conditions which will assist first responders to expedite the "triage" stage of the cyclists care. It was developed as a result of an injured cyclist having to wait at the hospital "triage" stage for this information, which could have been forwarded by the first responders. The hospital wait time to obtain this information resulted in the injured person dying. Doctors said the victim could have been saved if not for this delay. Our church is offering this Medical Data Carrier to parishioners and their direct family members who wear helmets for **free**. For friends and other family members they can be purchased for about \$5 from a source to be determined. There will be a sign-up sheet at the back of the church for the next for the next couple of Sundays. Please indicate how many you want for your direct family members. We will obtain them for you. **Property Committee Update:** Within the next few weeks the cemetery fencing on the north and east sides will be replaced with black wire fencing.
