From the Bishop: Call for Conscience Campaign 2018: The Bishops of Ontario, in conjunction with the Coalition for Healthcare and Conscience, are looking for 100,000 e-mail addresses as part of a campaign to encourage our elected Members of Provincial Parliament (MPPs) and those seeking office this June to increase funding for palliative care, to protect doctors and healthcare professionals who do not want to be involved in Medical Assistance in Dying (MAID), and to protect faith-based healthcare facilities from participating in MAID.
