This involves 2 volunteers for each session for a period of 2 hours to assist the regular employees. Most of our bingo assignments currently occur at 1pm on a Friday afternoon, with a couple at 10pm. Each participant is given a list of our assignments about 6 months in advance and our volunteers have an opportunity to indicate which one(s) they would be able to attend.
