meeting of the committee following the general meeting 9.5 AED: This has already been purchased by the Parish from a special Nevada Marie Pemberton fund. 9.6 Lion's Club: Under the chair of Community Life, Marie Minifie is asking the Mary Lou Hills council to consider donating funds to assist the local Lions Club with gifts and food baskets to families and individuals on low incomes. With the increase in the costs of living many charitable groups are finding it difficult to meet the increasing demands. It was suggested that consideration of providing funds for this request be deferred to next year and included in the 2016 budget. It was moved by Bernadette Burgess that CWL assist the Lions Club with the amount of \$200. This was seconded by Jane Burke. The motion was carried with one abstention and one negative vote. 10. **Standing Committees Reports** 10.1 **Spiritual Development**: In his homily this evening Father spoke about **Donna Guiney** forgiveness. Donna reminded us that Lenten Confessions would be held on April 1st at 6:30 in the evening. As well Father will hold a special Day of Adoration on April 12th following Confirmation: the hours would be from noon until 3:00. Ann LeClair will present Confirmation medals to candidates on April 12th... 10.2. **Organization:** Presentation on National's theme of One Heart, One Voice, Bernadette Veitch One Mission was deferred until end of meeting. 10.3 Community Life: Kelly was seeking a list of names that she could call on Palm Kelly Neville Sunday. Once again Kelly is involved with the annual Easter Seals Kingston area Telethon 10.4 Education: Educational officials and curriculum designers have asked that we Shirley McDonald remain calm and wait for their report as they look at the updated Provincial Health Curriculum that is to be implemented in all schools in Ontario 10.5 Health: Aaron Bailey had a previous commitment and was unable to speak at Marie Pemberton our May pot luck so he will be speaking at our April 14 meeting. Several present suggested that the members of the parish would be interested in hearing Aaron speak on his strategies for coping with ADHD. After lengthy discussions it was decided that Marie approach Aaron and let him know of our desire to invite members of the parish. We believe that, even throwing it open to the parish, there would be less people present to hear them then if he spoke at the Pot Luck. We would defer, of course, to Aaron's wishes. 10.6 Project Homeland: Added to the agenda by Donna Guiney. Donna reported Donna Guiney that donations included toothpaste, toothbrushes, coffee, gum, Sudoku books, pencils, etc. Monetary donations consisted off \$100.00. Carol and Roger Daigle will arrange for delivery of the items to CFB Kingston. 10.7 **Resolutions and Legislation**: National CWL will be busy dealing with several Danna Dobson hot topics such Supreme Court's decisions on assisted suicide, restoring Old Age Security funding to 64 years of age, etc. National is asking the government to set up a task force on women's issues and to make these issues campaign issues.
