- The third policy that Donna has been working on is to provide guidelines to our members when families request that The Catholic Women's League pray the Rosary at a deceased members wake.
- She is also working on a policy with Danna Dobson for holding meetings using technology such as Zoom and teleconference calls.

Donna asked Mary Lou Hills to provide her with the Policies and Procedures that she was working when she was Past President. Mary Lou reported that Margaret Barker had presented a policy and procedure dealing with the Executive position of Membership Convenor. Mary Lou had also added a section to the policy dealing with the position of Past President.

It was **moved** by Donna Guiney that we amend the per person cost for funeral luncheons. The recommendation was a raise from \$5.00 to \$10.00 due to inflation. **Seconded** by Shirley McDonald. - Since there is no host council for the convention, as in previous years, the Kingston Diocese of the CWL will host the convention. They are asking individual parish councils to take on such roles as greeters, helping with table decorations at the closing banquet, creating a Prayer Room, etc. Already one council has stepped forward to handle registration.
- On November 19th the Diocesan Council will be holding an information session on the changing
 organizational structure of The Catholic Women's League of Canada. The time is 9 a.am until 12:30 p.m.
 and is being held in 4 different locations with the same program being facilitated by 2 members of the
 Diocesan Executive at each location. Blessed Sacrament is the host for the Kingston and area councils
 and will be led by Mary Lou Hills, Bernadette Veitch and President, Lyne Tuepah.
