

## **SECOND SUNDAY OF EASTER REFLECTION:**

In the gospel passage this Sunday we join the twelve apostles who, afraid of the Jewish leaders, have locked themselves in a room. The risen Jesus, on the evening of the day of his resurrection, visits the apostles and gives them his peace. He sends them out to preach the good news and to forgive the sins of those who want to believe in God's great love.

Since 2000 this Second Sunday of Easter is also known as "Divine Mercy Sunday," which we celebrate to enhance our relationship with God so that we are closer to Him and also have more love for our neighbours.

***Divine Mercy Chaplet:*** Sunday, April 11<sup>th</sup> at 3 p.m. at Blessed Sacrament.

***Easter Season:*** Seven weeks – Easter to Pentecost – celebrate one great feast! Saint Athanasius called these fifty days 'The Great Sunday' in which we sing the Easter Alleluia throughout this Season of Joy.
