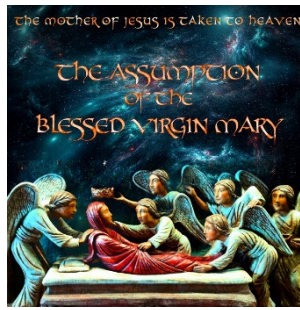
Notes from Father Shea
