



Solemnity of the Most Holy Body & Blood of Christ

This symbol of hope is the color of the sprouting seed and arouses in the faithful the hope of reaping the eternal harvest of heaven, especially the hope of a glorious resurrection.



Sunday Reflection: Corpus Christi June 6th

This Gospel recounts the events of the Last Supper when Jesus changed bread and wine into His Body and Blood, the greatest gift they could receive. “He was about to give them all that he is, before he gave himself to the world.”

Jesus offered his body and blood as food and drink for them so that they might grow in life and love. He commanded them to continue this meal in remembrance and celebration. Today, at the Eucharist, we are invited to share the Body and Blood of Jesus, to remember, to celebrate, and to grow in life and love.

Catholics Worldwide are urged to pray for Priests. The day was begun by Saint John Paul II in 2002 with the objective for the sanctification of Priests. The World Day of Prayer for Priests coincides with the Feast of the Sacred Heart of Jesus.

Sacred Heart of Jesus - June 11

“The Heart of Christ! His ‘Sacred Heart’ has given men everything: redemption, salvation, sanctification.”

— St. John Paul II, Homily on Divine Mercy Sunday, 2001

The Catechism teaches, “Jesus knew and loved us each and all during his life, his agony, and his Passion, and gave himself up for each one of us: ‘The Son of God ... loved me and gave himself for me’ [Gal 2:20]. He has loved us all with a human heart. For this reason, the Sacred Heart of Jesus, pierced by our sins and for our salvation, ‘is quite rightly considered the chief sign and symbol of that ... love with which the divine Redeemer continually loves the eternal Father and all human beings’ without exception” (CCC, 478).
