PALM SUNDAY REFLECTION:

As we celebrate Palm Sunday and begin our journey through Holy Week, we are called to ask ourselves who and where we are in the crowd. This is a week to pray and then decide what kind of followers of Christ we are and are going to be.

Reminder: Lent is a special spiritual time for us as individuals and as families. Today Holy Week begins. Make this a Holy Week for your family.

Easter Sunday – the greatest day of the Christian year – We praise God for his wonderful works of creation and salvation, especially for raising Jesus from the dead, revealing him as Saviour and Lord, the centre of salvation history. We rejoice today with all Christians, for our Father has made us sharers in the grace of his Son. By baptism, we die with him, are buried with him and are raised with him to glory. We share in his victory and his abundant new life.

Easter Season: Seven weeks – Easter to Pentecost – celebrate one great feast! Saint Athanasius called these fifty days 'The Great Sunday' in which we sing the Easter Alleluia throughout this Season of Joy.

Novena of Divine Mercy began on Good Friday – The Novena of Divine Mercy extends from Good Friday to Mercy Sunday, April 11th. The Lord promised “I will grant every possible grace to souls”. Novena: **see our Parish Website**. This year, on Mercy Sunday afternoon, (Sunday after Easter), the Divine Mercy Chaplet will be prayed at Blessed Sacrament at 3 pm.

Monday, April 26th is the Feast of Our Lady of Good Counsel – our CWL Patroness. As Catholic women, we promise to honour, invoke and imitate her. In 1910, the World Union of Catholic Women’s Organizations organized in Brussels. In Montreal, Canada, the Catholic Women’s League organized in June, 1920 and the WUCCWO, who had chosen Mary, under the title Our Lady of Good Counsel, as their patroness, invited Canada’s CWL to affiliate with the world-wide federation. In 1923, the CWL adopted Our Lady of Good Counsel as the League’s patroness. Please plan to join us for Mass, April 26th at 7 pm.

Church Trivia: The blessed palms you receive today on Palm Sunday are brought back to Church next February. Then they are burned to produce Ashes for next Ash Wednesday.
