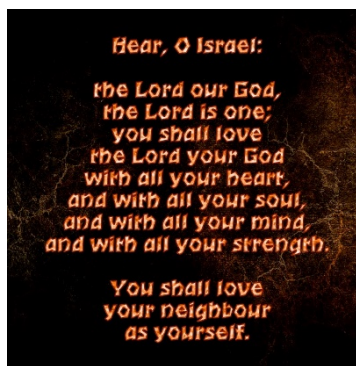
### **The Good, the Bad and the Funny**
