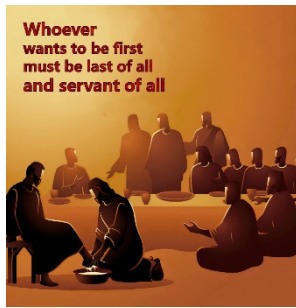

### Sunday Reflection: September 19<sup>th</sup>

Jesus identifies with a defenceless child, "Whoever welcomes one such child in my name welcomes me". His identification with the defenceless is as identification with God, "the one who sent me".
