Due to family and personal reasons, Rev. Robert Masters will be resigning as pastor of Paroisse St. François d'Assise, Kingston, and pastor of St. Barnaby, Brewers Mills. I would like to express my deepest appreciation to Father Bob, who has served the people of the parish of St. François d'Assise for the past 17 years and of St. Barnaby for the past 4 years. Along with his pastoral duties, Fr. Bob served the Archdiocese as Confessor for the Sisters of Providence of St. Vincent de Paul at Providence Motherhouse, Kingston, and as Chaplain at Joyceville and Millhaven prisons beginning in 2014.
