**Rosary in October:** For the 5 Sundays of October, we will be saying the Rosary before Mass, as October is the Month of the Holy Rosary. We will start at 10:10 am so please be respectful when coming into the Church. If you wish to lead the Rosary please let Maureen Eaton, or Deb Fischer know after Mass. For our own personal intentions while saying the Rosary, a box has been placed at the altar to hold these intentions. Paper and pencils are provided for you. We will keep them for the entire month of October.

**Promises of Mary to Those Who Pray the Rosary:** We will be publishing excerpts from The Promises of Mary to Those who Pray the Rosary, given to St. Dominic during the month of October. There are 15 promises. The first four Promises are:

1. Whoever shall faithfully serve me by the recitation of the Rosary, shall receive signal graces
2. I promise my special protection and the greatest graces to all those who shall recite the Rosary
3. The Rosary shall be a powerful armor against hell, it will destroy vice, decrease sin, and defeat heresies
4. It will cause virtue and good works to flourish; it will obtain for souls the abundant mercy of God; it will withdraw the hearts of men from the love of the world and its vanities, and will lift them to the desire of eternal things. Oh, that souls would sanctify themselves by this means.

**Apology by Catholic Bishops to our Indigenous People:** Catholic Bishops acknowledge the suffering indigenous peoples experienced in Residential Schools run by the Catholic Church. The Catholic Bishops expressed their profound remorse and apologized unequivocally. The Bishops pledged to fundraise to support indigenous initiatives for healing. Also, they committed to provide information to help memorialize those buried in unmarked graves. A delegation of indigenous survivors will meet with Pope Francis at the Vatican in December.
