Welcome and call meeting to order (Kelly Neville)

Kelly called the meeting to order at 7:38 p.m. - following Mass

1. Opening Prayer: Liz Guiney led us in the Prayer to Our Lady of Good Counsel

2. Spiritual Advisor's Report (Father Shea):

(Kelly Neville presented Father with a card that contained gift cards)

- Crowning of the statue of Mary will be at the 5:15 Mass on Saturday, May 20th.

- 7. President's Report: (Kelly Neville):

Kelly reported on the 101st Diocesan Convention. Mary Lou Hills thanked Susan Aubin. Margaret Wilson and Kelly Neville for their assistance with the convention as Greeters.

- 8. Treasurer's Report: (Danna Dobson)
 - Our current bank balance is \$5,536.67. Pending are 2 deposits: \$600 and \$100
 - Danna presented a list of Donations list as per suggestions from the membership and approved by the Executive prior to the meeting. Shirley McDonald distributed a sheet containing a brief explanation about each charity, or organization, of the listed recipients. It was noted that the Sharing Centre in Amherstview received a portion of the 5% Mission Committee's chosen charities. Since we already had donated \$100 to the Diocesan Voluntary Fund, called the Hope Fund, we still had \$700 to distribute. Under further discussion members present believed that we should approve the entire proposed donations list, as prepared by the Executive. Danna Dobson moved that we extend the amount to \$800. 11. Old Business:

- Silent Auction: (Shirley McDonald): Shirley has extended the time for donations to the Silent Auction to May 31st. The Silent Auction will be held on June 11th – in time for Father's Day. Danna Dobson will collect contributions from the basket while Shirley is away,
- Roast Beef dinner: (Margaret Wilson) Lyle Arcand, with co-coordinator Cathy Splinter, has set the 26th of May as the day to set up the tables; May 27th people will be preparing the food, 28th (night of the dinner) Cathy and Lyle will be looking for volunteers as greeters and for clean up. It will be a buffet style dinner. prepared. Greeters need to be there for 4:30 dinner starts at 5:00. The bishop has been invited.
- First Communion/Confirmation: (Donna Guiney and Father Shea) Their were 50 Communicants –held over 2 Masses – 11:00 and 1:00. Sean McDonald was the cantor, Deb McKee, Education chair, helped hand out the medal and card from the CWL and the Knights gave the children a Rosary.
- Father thanked everyone for the cards and gifts, as he celebrated his 75th Birthday on the 13th of April and celebrated _--- as a priest (April 22nd)

12. New Business:

Special Events Policy: Rosary for the Deceased: (Donna Guiney)

The Policy was presented – it had been sent out by the Secretary to members for their review- however there appeared to be some concern over wording. **Action:** Donna to bring it back to the Policy and Procedure committee for further discussion.

Mother's Day Carnations: (Mary Lou Hills/Donna Guiney)

The Co-ordinator of the Children's Liturgy committee proposed that the CWL and the parish present a carnation (flower) to mothers in the parish on Mother's day. The children would hand out the flowers. Those present suggested that all women should receive a flower at both Masses – the CWL greeters would hand them out on Saturday. In preparation for this, members of the Executive counted the number of women attending each Mass. Danna Dobson moved that the CWL would contribute half of the cost of the flowers.(Total cost \$300) \$75.00 would come from the Membership budget and the other half was donated by Margaret Wilson as her contribution from her communications committee.
